Velvet Cap Triple Cask is a high malt content small batch Irish whiskey, produced at the Blackwater Distillery in County Waterford, Ireland.

Background

Velvet Cap was founded in 1880 by Thomas Power of Dungarvan. His vision was to create new and unique flavours through barrel maturation, and this continues to be the focus of the brand today.

Taste Profile

After blending, the whiskey is rested in a selection of Bourbon, Port, and Stouted Rye casks. The taste profile is layered but youthful. A firm foundation of malt sets the stage with well balanced vanilla, plum, and caramalized agave playing support. Chocolate bonbons with a rich sherry centre deliver on the promise of a stouted finish.

Nose: Toasted almond breakfast cereal with notes of butter scotch and peat

Palate: Bright pie cherry, walnut husk, heather, note of mint. Peated underbelly

with rich, fruity grain backbone.

Finish: Long and mellow despite the touch of heat.

Nose: Red currant, dark sweet wine, figs and fruit salad, fruit cake, must, brown

sugar, carmalised muscat, pear

Palate: Dark cherry, vanilla, almond, dry biscuit, tannins, shortbread

Finish: Long lingering stone fruit and sultanas
